DEPOSIT: All patients are required to pay a deposit as per your choice of room in the 1st week of seventh Month. Every possible effort will be made to provide you with the type of accommodation booked. However this cannot be guaranteed and you should be prepared to accept whatever accommodation is available at the time of admission. You will be shifted to your preferred room at the earliest opportunity. Maternity registration fees of Rs. 10,000/- is non-refundable.

PRE / POST NATAL CLASSES: Pre-natal & Post - natal classes are conducted by the Physiotherapy Department of this Hospital. Those interested in joining these classes may contact the Physiotherapy Department or the Sister-incharge for further information (2366 7858)

THINGS TO BE BROUGHT FROM HOME

For Mothers:

- 1 Report of Blood Group & Rhesus Factor (V.Imp), HIV, HCV, HBsAg.
- 2 Receipts for Registration and Deposit paid.
- 3 Four front open short night dresses or bush coat.
- 4 One dressing Gown.
- 5 Toiletries.

For Babies:

The hospital provides sterlized napkins & kurtas for the babies during the period of their stay in the Hospital. For medical reasons no private linen is allowed. On Discharge, baby will be changed into his/her own Clothes.

INSTRUCTION FOR VISITORS

- 1 Not more than two persons will be allowed to remain in the lobby during the period of labour and upto the time of delivery.
- 2 Visiting hours are 11.00 a.m. to 12 noon 05.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.
- 3 Only two visitors are allowed to visit a patient at a time. They are requested not to sit on the patient's bed.
- 4 No children are allowed in the Maternity Unit. Only Siblings are permitted to visit their mothers on Sunday & Public Holidays between 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon & 5.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.
- 5 The hospital is not responsible for washing of private linen.
- 6 Expectant mothers are requested to meet the Nursing Superintendent of the Maternity Ward for any queries on Sat. between 12.30 p.m. to 1.00 p.m.
- 7 For medical reasons food and linen from outside / flowers / balloons/bouquets are not permitted in the Maternity Unit.
- 8 The canteen at the ground floor of the Hospital may be contacted for the food of the attendant. However, please note that no outside food will be allowed in the patient's room.
- 9 The Hospital will provide Bedsheets, Pillow, Blanket only at night for the attendant.
